



Wetland Futures 2015 – Sponsorship opportunities

Bridging the conservation gap between freshwater, saltwater & transitional wetlands

Wetland Futures Conferences are held biennially and are a forum that disseminates information, showcases best practice, allows debate and discussion and generally strengthens the delivery of wetland conservation in the UK.

Wetland Futures 2013 attracted 110 delegates from 53 different organisations and sectors including water companies, statutory agencies, universities, local authorities, consultancies and environmental NGOs. This year we additionally attract delegates from port and harbour authorities, landowners and members of the shell fisheries and aquaculture industries.

Our next conference is focusing on how we can work better together across all water environments, from source to sea. We aim to raise awareness of the inter-relationships between inland areas and the coast, and improve cooperation in ways that will not only benefit wetlands and the functions and services they provide, but also the productivity and efficiency of all those industries and agencies working within and affecting the water environment. Consequently we are expecting our conference to draw a range of delegates from a wide range of organisations, agencies and industry.

We are pleased to announce that the 2015 Wetland Futures conference will be held at the Priory Rooms, Birmingham on Wednesday 14th and Thursday 15th October 2015. There are currently a number of commercial opportunities available for organisations to help support this conference:
