Each year we offer a small number of opportunities to those looking to do long-term placements. These placements offer applicants a range of practical experiences and are ideal for people looking to gain valuable experience. This placement would suit those who enjoy being part of small enthusiastic teams, have a good variety of skills and love being outdoors.

This new placement provides a rare opportunity to gain practical experience with a wide range of animal species including birds, mammals and amphibians. This will be a varied role with activities including animal husbandry, assisting with animal training protocols and developing presentation skills.

We are looking for candidates can commit to volunteer for between 8 and 12 months, ideally commencing in August 2019. The role is full-time and may include weekends. There will be excellent opportunities to develop useful skills for the UK job market in areas of animal management, presentations and the zoo industry.

If volunteering as a student placement you will be able to carry out your own research project if required by your university as part of your assessment, supported by friendly WWT staff with significant experience in their field. Although the placements will be unpaid, free accommodation including utility bills is available.
