- 16 What is the name for the main group of animals that spend part of their time in water and part of their time on land? (Clue: This group includes, frogs, toads and newts).
Amphibians
- 17 Being able to fly enables many animals to travel between lots of different habitats. Can you name an animal, other than an insect or a bird, that can fly?
Bat
- 18 There's a type of habitat made up mainly of grassland with some small trees. Animals such as zebras, lions and cheetahs live there. Can you name this habitat?
Savanna (or savannah)
- 19 Which habitat do you think covers the largest area of the earth?
Ocean
- 20 This type of habitat can be either very hot or very cold. This makes this habitat difficult places for animals to survive. What is this habitat?
Desert (cold deserts are found in the Antarctic, Greenland, Iran, Turkestan, Northern and Western China)
